***Review of the Protection of Wild Mammals (Scotland 2002) Act***

I am contacting you as I would like you to make sure that the spirit of the Provision of the Wild Mammals Act (Scotland 2002) is upheld and enforced with the killing of foxes and other mammals by packs of dogs being properly banned in Scotland:

1. Ban the use of hounds to deliberately chase wild mammals and only allow drag hunting in Scotland
2. Restrict the number of hounds that can be deliberately used to flush out foxes to a maximum of two
3. Make it compulsory for hounds to be fitted with suitable muzzles when being used to flush out foxes
