The representation from North Kelvin Community Council which is identied as date published 5 February 2013 on the Council web site will not open.

I refer to the consultations contained to on page 2 of the committee report. Again I can only identify the consultation responses from SNH and SEPA although the letter from SEPA dated 26 May 2015 refers to their previous letter dated 17 December 2012 (their reference PCS/123922). There is reference to comments from Glasgow Life (Sport and Infrastructure Supply) on Page 3 of the Committee Report. I can not find/Identify this document on the web site









I have not gone through all the documents contained on the web site but there appears still to be problems with it. The message from the Drainage Imact assessment document is 'Damaged and Could not be opened'. You may wish to check the other documentation on your web site to ensure they are not corrupted in any way before submitting a response to this letter
