## **TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997 NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT: SUPPLEMENTARY GUIDANCE**

I refer to your correspondence of 22 November 2023, notifying Scottish Ministers of your intention to adopt an item of Supplementary Guidance in connection with the East Dunbartonshire Local Development Plan, adopted December 2022:

- Frontiers of the Roman Empire (Antonine Wall) World Heritage Site – Supplementary Guidance

Scottish Ministers do not propose to issue a direction in relation to these documents.

Prior to adopting this document as supplementary guidance, your Authority should satisfy itself that it has met the requirements set out in the Town and Country Planning (Development Planning) (Scotland) Regulations 2008. In particular, we would bring to your attention the need to comply with section 27(2) of the above regulations, which state that supplementary guidance adopted and issued under section 22(1) of the 1997 Act<sup>1</sup> (in connection with a particular local development plan), may only deal with the provision of further information or detail in respect of the policies or proposals set out in the plan and then only provided that those are matters which are expressly identified in a statement contained in the plan as matters which are to be dealt with in supplementary guidance.
