I refer to your Council's letter of 4 May 2017 with which a copy of the planning application relating to the above development was notified to Scottish Ministers in accordance with the above mentioned Direction.

While noting concerns raised in relation to the historic environment, Scottish Ministers are satisfied that the proposal does not raise issues that would warrant determination by central government and that Glasgow City Council is best placed to take this decision. It is not, therefore, Scottish Ministers' intention to intervene in this application by either issuing a direction restricting the granting of planning permission or by calling in the application for their own determination. Accordingly, your Council are hereby authorised to deal with the application in the manner it thinks fit.
