## **TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997**

## DIRECTION THAT APPEAL WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE SCOTTISH MINISTERS

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by paragraph 3(1) of Schedule 4 to the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997, hereby direct that they will determine the above-mentioned appeal instead of a person appointed by them.

The reason for this Direction is because Scottish Ministers place a high priority on the delivery of good quality housing that can contribute to the creation of successful and sustainable places. They continue to take an active role in monitoring the practical application of the Scottish Planning Policy, particularly the presumption in favour of development that contributes to sustainable development. As a result, they wish to recall appeals for housing proposals over 100 units to monitor how this national policy is being implemented. This appeal is being recalled for Ministers' decision as it is over 100 housing units in size.
