
- Foot and Mouth Disease [Low risk no change] In May, a small number of outbreaks of FMD were reported in Israel (1), Libya (6) and Morocco (1).
- Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza [Low risk for wild bird incursion no change] In May, small numbers of outbreaks of HPAI H5N1 were reported domestic poultry in Vietnam (1) and Nepal (1), HPAI H5N2 in Taiwan (6), HPAI H5N8 in Nigeria and HPAI H7N3 in Mexico (5).
- African Swine Fever [Medium risk no change] In May, in Europe, ASF is still circulating in backyard and commercial premises in Poland (2), Romania (20) and Ukraine (3).Cases in wild boar have been reported in Belgium (40), Hungary (48), Latvia (16), Lithuania (41), Moldova (2), Poland (187), Romania (33), and Russia (4). In Asia, China (5), Vietnam (24), Hong Kong (1) and North Korea (1) have reported new outbreaks of ASF in domestic pigs. Elsewhere, there were 2 outbreaks of ASF in South Africa.
- Classical Swine Fever [Very low risk no change] In May, Japan has reported 36 outbreaks of CSF; in commercial pigs (3), slaughter house (2) and wild boar (31). There were no reports of CSF from elsewhere.
- Bluetongue [Low risk no change] In May, Germany has reported 2 outbreaks of BTV-8. Italy has reported 3 outbreaks of BTV-4. There have been no reports of BTV-8 or BTV-4 in France or Belgium this month.
- Newcastle disease [Low risk no change] In May, USA continues to report Newcastle Disease in backyard exhibition flocks and non-commercial domestic poultry in California (20). Elsewhere, there have been outbreaks of ND in backyard poultry in Mexico (2), Cambodia (1) Israel (2) and Russia (1).



African swine fever in domestic pigs and wild suidae since January 2019








Classical swine fever in Japan since September 2018
