Member Appointed to Orkney NHS Board

MEMBER

APPOINTMENT

This appointment will be for four years and will run from 8th February 2021 to 7th February 2025.

This appointment is regulated by the Ethical Standards Commissioner.

REMUNERATION

This appointment is part-time and attracts a remuneration of £8,095 per annum for a time commitment of one day per week.

OTHER MINISTERIAL APPOINTMENTS

Joanna Kenny does not hold any other public appointments.

POLITICAL ACTIVITY

All appointments are made on merit and political activity plays no part in the selection process. However, in accordance with the original Nolan recommendations, there is a requirement for appointees' political activity within the last five years (if there is any to be declared) to be made public.

Joanna Kenny has had no political activity within the last five years.
