# BTP Integration Joint Programme Update

## Purpose:

1. The purpose of the attached Paper JPB 03-06 is to provide members with a Programme Update.

### **Key Information:**

2. Seven project leads have now been identified to take forward the projects in the Programme. Workforce and Pensions (Project 2) will consist of 2 workstreams due to the significant and complex nature of the work involved. It is also proposed that Legislation (Project 1) could consist of 2 workstreams, namely primary and secondary legislation, with PMU leading on primary and DfT leading on secondary. A project lead for Operational Integration has been identified, although initial discussions are still ongoing.
