# BTP Integration Joint Programme Board Legislation Update

#### Purpose:

1. To update the Joint Programme Board on timescales and next steps for parliamentary consideration of the Scottish Government's primary legislation on railway policing.

## Key Information:

- 2. The Railway Policing (Scotland) Bill was introduced in the Scottish Parliament on 8<sup>th</sup> December 2016, with the Bill and accompanying documents being published on the following day. - 3. Justice Committee has been designated as the lead Committee for parliamentary scrutiny of the Bill, and has issued a call for written evidence, with a deadline of 31<sup>st</sup> January 2017 for submissions. - 4. The Justice Committee is expected to confirm timings shortly for the oral evidence sessions to inform its Stage 1 consideration of the Bill. Our current understanding is that the timetable for Stage 1 is likely to run until the beginning of May. While this is later than our planning assumptions as previously communicated to the JPB, we still expect the subsequent Stage 2 and 3 consideration to complete by the end of June as per the overall timescales envisaged. We will keep the JPB updated as firmer indications become available.
