Many thanks for taking the time to speak with me earlier this afternoon. It was extremely useful indeed. As I mentioned during my call, please find below some bullet points summarising what we discussed. I am copying the most helpful [REDACTED] in this email so that we all are on the same page.

- Any transport and transfer will be arranged for through the British Embassy in Vienna;
- [REDACTED]
- The lunch dinner on the Friday is organised by a private company. It is not yet
 possible to know who is going to attend. The same applies for the heurigen on
 Saturday evening.
- Ms Hyslop is invited to attend the lunch hosted by the Mr Kurz on the Saturday at about 12:30. She will be seated at the Ministerial table. (It is foreseen that...) Mr Kurz will be leaving straight after lunch;
- Media will be present, mainly Austrian. They might ask questions in the margins but there will be no press conferences Correct. As far as we know, no journalist from the UK has been accredited. Prof. Lendvai invited some journalists from Switzerland, Spain, Ukraine and Hungary. So most journalist will come from central Europe. Journalist will be present during the plenary, but as far as I have been told, it is unusual that they ask for interviews.

The dinner on the Saturday is hosted by the Government of Lower Austria. We expect Ms Barbara Schwarz and Mr Lambertz to attend.

- Ms Hyslop is expected to speak for no longer than 15 minutes. There will be no Q&A
- German-English translation will be provided
- There will be a lunch on Sunday straight after the plenary

Info I would be grateful if you could provide:

- Name of the restaurant where the dinner will be held on the Saturday It should take
 place at the Heurigen Knoll (http://www.loibnerhof.at/) in the nearby town of
 Dürnstein (King Richard Lionhart was kept imprisoned in Dürnstein).
- Running order for the speeches on Sunday. Ms Hyslop will go third but who will she
 be introduced by? Prof. Lendvai will introduce all the speakers.
 - Will there be a lectern? Will Ms Hyslop speak from a stage? Yes and yes (you can find a picture of the lectern on: https://europaforum.at/archiv/european-forum-wachau-2014/)
- Is there any dress code for lunch/dinner? Dress code for the lunch would be normal business and for the heurigen, business casual. In fact there is no strict dress code.
- My Communication colleagues have asked whether they could be provided with contact details for the organisers' media office. I am still working on that, but since there is no real press corner, it is difficult to find a contact. Maybe you could send me there questions and I will try to answer.

Concerning the working group 4, this working group is already complete (around 40 people). In fact, it is not foreseen that speakers take part in any working group, but if they wish to do so, we will of course do our best to enable them the participation. Usually less people attend the working group then have registered. I would therefore propose to wait the end of the lunch on Saturday and then to decide whether to participate or not.

I will get back to you asap with info on our plans in terms of flights, accommodation, dinners and names of the people who will accompany our Cabinet Secretary.

Thanks again for your very kind help. Let me know if any of the above details is not accurate and whether you need any other info from me.
