The PM is in town to participate in a Quint meeting hosted by the Chancellor in the margins of President Obama's farewell visit to Berlin. Would Mr Russell perhaps have time for a meeting on Thursday before the reception starts?

Should that not work, would be happy to meet Mr Russell for breakfast on Friday.

On logistics, Mr Russell will have to make his way quickly from Schönefeld to the Adlon to be in time for the panel which I believe starts at 3pm. The roads should be clear coming from Schönefeld but

central Berlin will be tricky to navigate due to the President's visit. We're happy to provide transport, also on Friday, but I'm afraid we would have to charge you.

On Friday, I think Mr Russell would have to leave central Berlin already around 09:30 in order to be at Schönefeld in time. 
