
I look forward to seeing you again at Celtic Connections in 2018.

Hi there Fiona

How are you? I hope you got back from Lorient safely and that the Edinburgh Festivals have not seen you be too busy, although I suspect they will have.

I just wanted to write to you and thank you so so much for not only coming to Lorient, but for supporting the initiative from the outset. I am not sure that without your support the event

would every have been realised. This focus on Scotland is a unique in so many ways and a first in so many ways. A huge thanks from me and all the Showcase Scotland Expo team.

It was undoubtedly a successful working partnership and to have so many agencies working together for the first time, yet understanding each others objectives and delivering such a huge focus, is something that I sincerely hope can be repeated for future events both at Lorient and others. It would not have been achievable without all the partners, not just financially but in terms of human resources.

The outcomes are still pouring in and it will take some time to be able to evaluate it all, but as you know the media coverage for Scotland was extremely significant both here and in Europe.

There are still two documentaries to be aired here on BBC Alba and also on Radio Scotland, with two pieces of film on France TV 3. Elephant Sessions were featured in Rolling Stone Magazine France and also entered the French download charts! - which is exceptional for any roots genre band.

The artists undoubtedly achieved a huge amount and our Pavilion has been described by the festival as the best Pavilion in the history of the festival, it was packed at all) Their fees were more than the sum of money we collectively invested in the events delivery (I will get a full report done for your teams and send it over, still collating all the info - but we know the amounts paid to Scottish musicians exceeded the amount collectively invested in delivering the event.) Several onward bookings have been registered and Elephant Sessions are performing in London on the 1st of September for Belhaven Beers with more offers for artists coming in as I type.

In addition to this being the first time that Showcase Scotland Expo have managed to work with all the partners, it is also the case that its the first time we have secured commercial sponsorship


I also think that for the younger artists the experience was a huge learning curve and you could see as the week progressed that they were all picking up tips from each other that were put to use in improving their performances. Stage craft really benefitted and it's an experience that these artists will carry for life and one that I believe has made a huge difference to them in so many ways.

So once again a huge thanks to you! I know how busy you were on that weekend and it would have been easy not to get on a plane, but you did and the difference that having you there made to everyone including myself is massive. The artists were so pleased that you were visible as part of the focus, so were the sponsors, the media, our team and from a personal point of view myself. Thank you, Thank you and I hope the rest of the Festival goes well for you.

PS I know you didn't get a chance to see Elephant sessions, but if you go to the Showcase Scotland Facebook page you will see one of Euan from the band crowd surfing on a giant inflatable pineapple!
