


Colleagues,



Please see the below response from NHS Borders regarding your further query:

ECR stands for Extra Contractual Referral request.

This is a local protocol used within NHS Borders where clinicians are asked to gain authorisation of funding prior to referring patients to providers of care where treatments and services that are not normally provided by NHS Borders or through a service level agreement with other NHS providers is available.

A brief summary of the process is as follows:

- The local GP or consultant will fill in an ECR request form and send it into the commissioning team who facilitate the process.
- The form should contain details such as the patient's medical history, prognosis of the
 patient, an outline of the proposed treatment/service including an indication of the duration
 of the treatment & evidence of the clinical and cost effectiveness of the treatment/service
 (such as from SIGN or NICE guidance) and other sources of clinical evidence (such as from
 the Cochrane Centre) should be given wherever possible.
- All information is checked for completeness, anonymised and the request logged on a database ready for the next ECR panel.
- The request is taken to the next planned ECR panel who meet fortnightly.
- Once a decision is made by the ECR panel the referrer is informed of the decision within 5 working days of the decision being made.
- If the ECR panel have asked for further information from the clinician this would be taken back to the ECR panel for a further decision to be made following receipt of the information.
- Where emergency situations arise these are dealt with usually virtually if possible but following the full ECR protocol.

Apologies for the delay in replying to you. Please see the below response from NHS Borders:

The NHS Borders spinal service is undertaken by our Consultant Orthopaedic surgeons or by the Rheumatology service, depending on the nature of the underlying problem. We are not aware of any problems or issues with the service and our practice is that people are referred onwards as required to the nationally funded service for Scottish patients with spinal injuries in Glasgow. No ECR requests have been received this year for spinal services in Glasgow and if further details can be supplied, we would be happy to explore further what the underlying problem or concern may be.
