It was a pleasure to meet with you in London on 22 November and thought you might be interested in my recent visit to Malta.

I had the opportunity to attend a number of sessions at the 7th World Summit on Arts and Culture during my visit. It was a very interesting conference and I was impressed by the dynamism with which contributors addressed the common issues that cultural and creative practitioners and leaders around the world currently face.

Minister for Justice, Culture and Local Government, Hon. Owen Bonnici, kindly invited me to meet with him and representatives of Arts Council Malta over lunch and we discussed our many shared interests and areas in which we might encourage greater collaboration between Malta and Scotland into the future. For example, the Create 2020 Strategy recently launched by Arts Council Malta provides a strong example as we seek to develop a culture strategy for Scotland. We discussed collaboration between Malta and Scotland, perhaps around our Year of Young People in 2018 and Valetta's holding of the European Capital of Culture title in the same year. 'Chrysalis', Scotland's new festival of theatre for young people recently hosted a youth theatre group from Malta, Teatru Manoel Youth Theatre. They performed in one of Edinburgh's most prominent theatres, the Traverse, and have received good reviews. I would be pleased if Dr Bonnici could visit me in Scotland, perhaps during August so he can take part in our world-leading festivals.

I had a meeting with Dr Ian Borg, Parliamentary Secretary for the 2017 Presidency and EU Funding, it was interesting to hear about Malta's preparations for the forthcoming EU Presidency and how Malta are determined to lead the Presidency and re-connect with EU citizens over issues that mattered to them.







I also met with Dr George Vella, Minister for Foreign Affairs for Malta and we had a discussion on a number of topics such as European issues, historic links with Europe and the Commonwealth. We also discussed Scotland's position on the EU Referendum result and the work of the Scotlish Government in seeking to protect Scotland's place in Europe.

I found all the meetings during my visit to Malta very valuable. I would like to take this opportunity to wish you all the best for your forthcoming Presidency.

I look forward keeping in touch and to further strengthening the relationship between Scotland and Malta. Sind regards
