Dear Stevie,

I have reviewed your applications to permit algal farming at the existing licensed mussel farms at Loch Etive. On cross checking the information on your new applications with that on the existing mussel licences, I found a couple of discrepancies that I wanted to confirm before progressing your applications any further.

Site 2: Sgeir a Chait

- The existing mussel licence includes 3 boat moorings. If these are in the water, or planned to be then they should be included on the new application.

Site 3: Rubha nan Carn

- The existing shellfish farm licence lists 10 rafts however the new application only includes 5. Please can you confirm the number of rafts that you would like to be included on any revised licence for the site?

Hi Louise,

Sorry this is all coming back to you piecemeal.

Attached is a Marine Scotland document from the applicant which states the inclusion of (native and pacific) oyster consent at one site (site 1) only, not two sites as the applicant thought.

I am still awaiting the coordinates of the 3 moorings at site 2 and will amend to show 10 rafts rather than the 5 in the paperwork I was given.

In the meantime, if it doesn't cause more issues, the licensing for sites 1,3,4 and 5 can proceed while I await the last pieces of information for you.

I reattach the area chart you already approved to go with each application.

Let me know if that is ok to proceed or if you still wish to wait for the complete Site 2 details before processing the 5 applications. Which ever way suits you is fine by me.
