In the next few months the UK Science and Technology Committee are to carry out an inquiry to explore the potential roles that hydrogen and hydrogen fuel cells may play in future energy systems. The focus will be on the utility of hydrogen in the decarbonisation of heat, power and transport sectors in a cost-efficient way, and in parallel, will explore how the Government's approach can be better coordinated to deliver optimal outcomes.
