I have just heard from the Scottish Police Authority that they have decided to refer a further complaint against the Chief Constable to the Police Investigations and Review Commissioner. The referral will be made today, and PIRC will then make an assessment before commencing an investigation, at which point they normally put out a public statement. The fact that there is a third complaint has already been widely reported in the media but I nevertheless expect any PIRC announcement to attract significant attention. We will stay in close contact with PIRC about the timing and content of any announcement they plan to make.

The SPA Board is meeting tomorrow and the Chief Executive advises that they will need to discuss the situation regarding the Chief Constable's leave [REDACTED]. This will be done in closed session. The Chief Executive will let me know immediately if anything changes on that front.

SPA is also assessing a fourth complaint [REDACTED]. I have asked them to keep us informed of developments in that case.
