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# 1 Content for online Help section (CMS)

# 1.1 Text currently in the SNSA Help section

# 1.1.1 Current reference to offline assessment application

Offline assessment criteria

An offline solution for the SNSA is being developed. Schools requiring the offline solution should contact the SNSA service desk.

### 1.2 Proposed replacement text

ACER would recommend replacing this with some more detailed information for schools once the offline solution is available. Text is included below. ACER would appreciate input on whether this should be displayed anywhere other than on the 'Help with SNSA Administration' page.

# 1.2.1 Proposed new reference to offline assessment application

Offline assessment

Schools with very limited or no Internet connectivity are able to administer the SNSA via an offline application.

The offline application enables learners to log in and complete assessments which are identical to those in the online SNSA system.

Before the assessments can be reported on, results from the offline application will need to be imported into the online SNSA platform.

Certain criteria must be met in order to access the offline application. Schools that have significant difficulty administering the SNSA to learners online should submit a request for access to the offline application via the SNSA Service Desk.

# 2. Text to be used by Service Desk on first contact

As outlined in ASO7A-O3\_Offline App Distribution workflow\_v0.2, schools will be required to lodge a request for the SNSA offline application via the SNSA Service Desk. The Service Desk will then gather information from the user to enable the ACER UK Online Service Manager (OSM) to determine whether the school is eligible to receive the offline solution.

Recommended text for use by the SNSA Service Desk upon receiving an enquiry about the offline application is included in 2.1 below.

The service desk will only escalate a request to the OSM when all the evidence requested below has been provided.

The ACER UK SM will then contact the nominated staff member to arrange access after assessing the criteria and deeming they pass access to the offline solution.

If they fail the request, the ACER SM informs the Service Desk who can advise the school on how they can actually access the online solution by staggering logins to overcome limited bandwidth issues.

# 2.1 Reply to offline app user enquiry

Dear xx,

Thank you for your enquiry.

The offline application enables learners to log in and complete assessments which are identical to those in the online SNSA system.

Before the assessments can be reported on, results from the offline application will need to be imported into the online SNSA platform.

To access the SNSA offline application, certain criteria must be met. To determine whether your school is eligible, please provide the Service Desk with the following:

- a screenshot of the <u>technical browser exam</u> showing that your school has failed to meet network capabilities for online delivery
- a description of the infrastructure, computers, devices and software currently in use at your school
- an SNSA offline application access request letter from your Local Authority or IT support for access to the offline application
- a named contact at your school who will take on the role of Offline Assessment Manager.
   This person will be provided with additional permissions on the SNSA system enabling them to import results. This staff member will be responsible for ensuring the security of the assessment content.

Note: the following minimum technical requirements must be met to run the offline application and report on completed assessments.

SNSA offline application – requirements for children and young people sitting the assessments:

- PC Windows 7 and later (64 bit)
- Minimum screen resolution of 1024x768

Reporting – requirements for the Offline Assessment Manager:

- Mac or Windows PC
- Internet connection of minimum 56 bit/s

# 3 'Read me' for inclusion in offline solution delivery

The following sections present draft text for the 'Read me' document contained in the offline solution delivery zip. Once content has been finalised, this text will be formatted to include SNSA design features and submitted as a PDF.

#### 3.1 Overview

The Scottish National Standardised Assessments (SNSA) offline delivery solution is a desktop application that enables children and young people to take the SNSA without Internet connectivity.

The software accompanying this instructions document is pre-configured with assessments for you. The application can be delivered via a local network or USB, and results are written to a folder in the software directory.

Users are created when the application is launched by an administrator. The administrator should enter the learner's username, as the username is the unique identifier for the assessment results, and the administrator password.

After logging in, the first screen a learner sees is their dashboard. From here, they can start the relevant assessment. Once the assessment is launched, the experience of the child or young person is exactly the same as that of a learner taking the assessment online.

On completion of an assessment, a record is saved to a separate folder in the software directory (the responses folder). This results file can then be uploaded to the SNSA system where it will be automatically marked. Following this, reports can be generated using the standard procedure.

Step-by-step instructions for launching the application and uploading results are included later in this document.

### 3.2 Technical requirements

Offline Application

- PC Windows 7 and later (64 bit)
- Minimum screen resolution of 1024x768

Administration and Reporting

- Mac or Windows PC
- Internet connection of minimum 56 bit/s

Notes: Assessments completed offline rely on the computer's internal clock for calculating the date an assessment is started and completed. If the internal clock on the computer isn't accurate, incorrect times may be recorded.

#### 3.3 Step-by-step instructions

#### 3.3.1 Login details

To log learners in to the offline application, a username and password are required:

- Password: this is the administrator password provided to you by the ACER UK Online Service Manager. If you did not receive this password, or if you have forgotten it, please contact the SNSA Service Desk.
- Username: this should be unique to the learner, and we recommend using the SNSA
  username. If you do not use the SNSA username, a duplicate user will be created in your
  SNSA system that will not be linked to SEEMiS. To access the SNSA usernames, follow the
  steps below.

To generate a list of login details from within your SNSA account:

- 1. Go to the Learners page and select the relevant learners
- 2. Select **Login Details**. A pop-up will open and display a list of usernames for the selected children or young people.
- 3. If required, you can download or print the login details from the Learner login details pop-up by clicking **Download login details** and saving the Excel spreadsheet.

Note that you do not need the learner passwords for the offline app; only the Administrator password is required.

# 3.3.2 Sitting assessments

- 1. Launch the application
- 2. You will be presented with a login screen. Fill in the learner's unique username in the 'ID' field and the administrator password provided by the OSM in the 'Admin Password' field.
- 3. Select 'Login'.
- 4. You will be taken to the learner's dashboard, where you will see a list of assessments for all year groups. Please ensure that the child or young person selects the appropriate assessment.
- 5. To start an assessment, simply click on its name and the learner is ready to go.

If you need to close the assessment for any reason before the assessment has been completed by the learner, please use the administrator shutdown procedure: [redacted]. You will be given the option of either logging out, or closing the application.

#### 3.3.3 After the assessment

Please make sure that the learner selects the 'Finish' button after the last page to submit their assessment.

When a learner has completed an assessment and has no more assessments to complete in the session, the administrator can close the application or log the learner out to allow another learner to log in.

To open the dialogue box to enable a logout or to close the application, press the following keys at once: [redacted]. Choose 'Logout' or 'Close application'.

# 3.3.4 Uploading results

Once the children or young people have finished their assessments and you have closed the application, you can copy the completed results files to a computer with Internet connectivity and upload them to the SNSA System.

The completed assessment sittings are located in the [redacted] folder. Once copied to a computer (Windows or OSX) with Internet access, the Offline Assessment Manager can log in to the SNSA system and upload the files.

If you have multiple files from one learner, you can zip them together using your operating system's zip utility. The files are named with the username that was entered prior to launching the assessment.

#### To upload:

- 1. Log in to your SNSA account
- 2. Navigate to the Learners page
- 3. Select Manage > Import ZIP/JSON Results. Use the form to upload your file(s).

The records are now stored in the SNSA system and are immediately available to report on. Please see the online Help and Training material for more information about using the SNSA system, including information on generating reports.

Before we respond in any detail, it might be best if we can resolve a few points first:

As a general point we would expect to be reviewing this feedback in conjunction with an updated FR/NFR document, ie where we have suggested amendment/addition of requirements (eg point 12 concerning OSNFR03), while the point may have been responded to, unless we can see evidence that it's now reflected in the requirements then it's only partially resolved.

The strikethrough which was on the first three points was, we suspect, a consequence of the corruption of the feedback log that happened in December, so we've removed the strikethrough and would like these points to be addressed please.

Where points 6, 8 and 14 address validation of a user (in particular, upload of completed assessments) it would perhaps be useful if the detail of this aspect could be teased out separately so that we understand better how it is proposed that it works. Obviously this is likely to be documented subsequently via user stories but as things stand we're maybe not confident that we clearly understand how this would work, and therefore whether the currently stated requirements are sufficient.
