

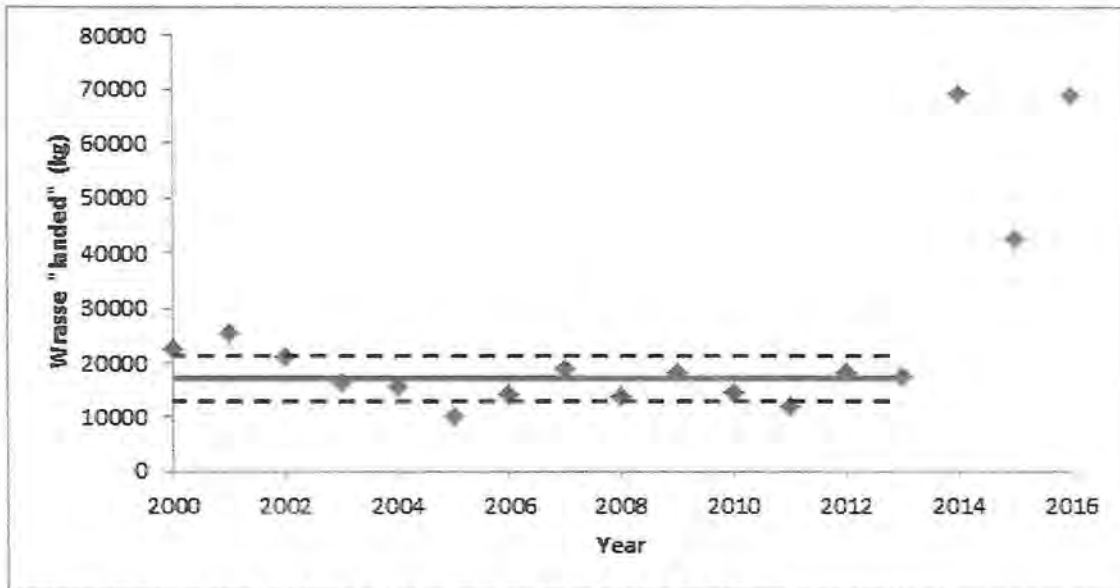

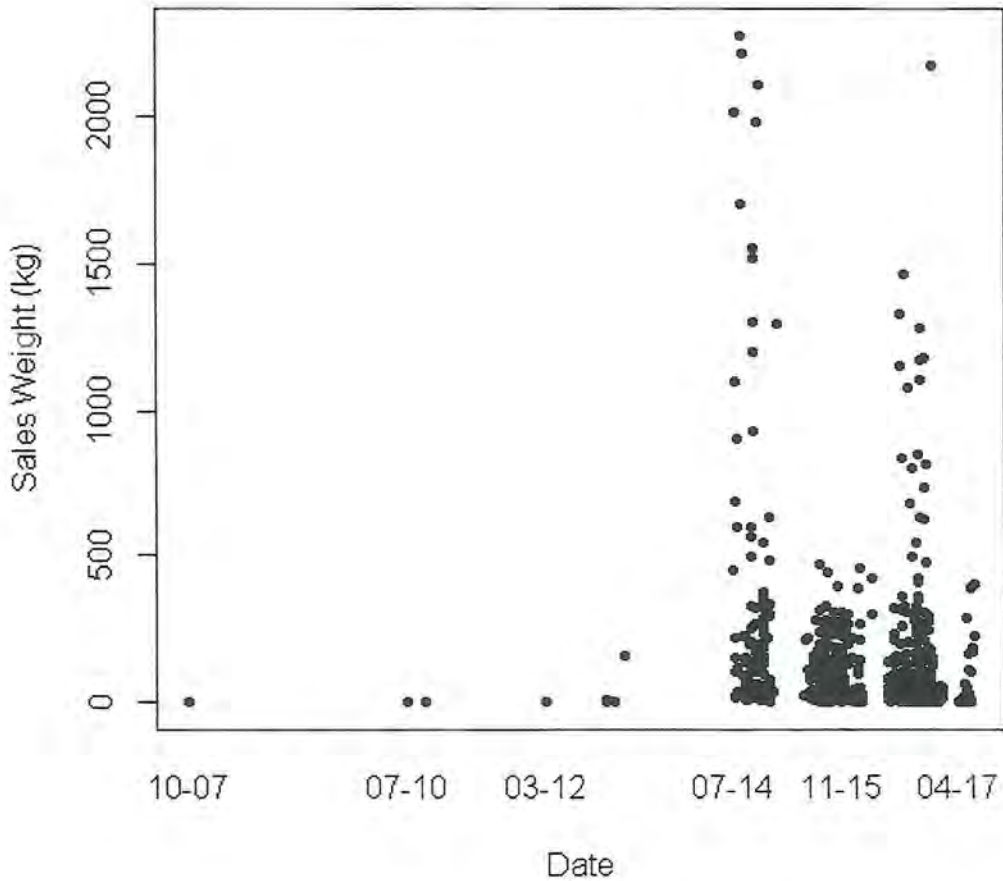
Thanks for the interest.

The numbers are from MMO data (available with all UK landing data from the MMO website at <https://www.gov.uk/government/statistical-data-sets/uk-fleet-landings-and-foreign-fleet-landings-into-the-uk-by-port>) but they have been summarised in the CEFAS wrasse report (attached) but note that as stated in my response this is UK wide. See Table 1. In the report For landings between 2000 – 2013 across the UK. I used this data as summarised in the following figure in my presentation at MASTS which I sent you previously. You will note that there is there was an annual mean of some 17kt (ranging between some 10 – 25kt) .



Wrasse landings in to UK ports (data taken from Riley et al 2017)

I have been working with the sales data for Scotland to try and gather some information for Scotland. I can only find records of "wrasse" going back until 2007. Before that, I understand that they were just lumped in to "other demersal fish" category. The vast majority of sales entries has occurred since Jan 2014, ~97% of sales (greater by weight). I have summarised them below. You will note that there is some difference between MMO and Marine Scotland Compliance sales data, but this is acknowledged in the CEFAS report that there is a delay in reporting and they report at a UK level not Scotland.
