Recap on Agreements & Actions from 3rd August 2017

- Sharing updates within our organisations it was agreed that members
 would update their respective organisations and elected representatives on
 progress, but that this should not pre-empt the conclusions and
 recommendations that will be presented in the Group's report.
- **Teacher engagement** it was noted that full and formal consultation with teachers was not practicable within the timeline to 8th September. However, it was agreed that:
 - Wider opportunities for engagement with teachers should be explored in the first phase, for example through existing collaboratives and networks:
 - Recommendations for focussed consultation with teachers and other key stakeholders should be included in the Group's report.
- Areas where no consensus can be reached it was agreed that issues on which there is a difference of perspective should be explored in an open way and reflected in the Group's report.
- A number of papers were commissioned for discussion at future meetings:

 - Functions and Leadership Jane / Graeme and ADES to lead (for the following meeting)
 - Accountability Jim / Clare / Karen and Lauren to lead for the meeting after Functions).

 or inputs it would be useful to have from the existing collaboratives/ regional
 groupings. Lisa will collate those questions for discussion at the next meeting.
