Nice to speak to you yesterday evening and thanks for making time for the call.

I attach the SOC, current WIP, for the University of St Andrews led Eden Campus proposal at Guardbridge. This has come on considerably. There are still areas for development such as around cyber security and this is in hand with discussions ongoing with other institutions in the Tay Cities region. The process for Tay Cities advances and the SOC is on the timeline required.

There is a strong reference framework now in the SOC for the UK Industrial Strategy and the continuing fit and drive to achieve aspects of the Scottish Economic Strategy and the pursuit of the 4is.

The University after consideration and joint discussion with the Council are now proposing that their activity is focused on the Tay Cities deal. This is based on the emerging strategy and shape for that deal, the closer collaboration and discussions developing on common themes with players, including academic institutions, within the Tay Cities and the opportunity for engagement and linkages, physically and operationally, with parts of the city region.

Accordingly I will be advising the colleague authorities in E&SESCRD of this step this week.

On the recognition of the Fife proposals in the city deal processes I found our discussion helpful. We discussed the progress made on the transportation aspects of the infrastructure involved through the TAG process and engagement with Alison Irvine and colleagues. However I was aware of a risk of other related infrastructure being overlooked as not transportation or linked with the housing infrastructure approach.

You were comfortable with the presentation through different streams and no need to re bundle aspects currently but it would be good to reassert what these other elements are and where they sat for ongoing consideration by Scottish and UK government colleagues. Accordingly as we discussed Morag Millar will provide copies of the SOCs for the infrastructure led proposals to ensure these are sighted. This is primarily the Fife based items and the Tweedbank proposal in SBC area.

Let me know if there is anything else that would assist currently. And thanks again for the chance to speak and think through aspects of the city deal.

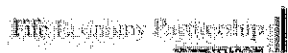

Really helpful to see this draft, thank you for sharing. I've made a couple of comments that you can take or leave as you see fit. I see several references to an undefined policy context from Scottish Government. Given the nature of city deals there is no prescriptive approach, but I wonder whether that's quite the same thing. The recent programme for government reference should provide some certainty.

We're also in the process of refreshing our cities strategy – the Agenda for Cities – and that will provide a clearer statement of the policy. However, you can expect that it will build on the Economic Strategy, the Programme for Government and the current discussions underway on city deals.
