At present your vessel is not licensed because you have not returned application forms. This gives me no option but to remove the licence from the vessel and create a hip pocket entitlement.

In your case this will run from 1 July 2010 until 30 June 2015 as this is when your fishing licence expired.

Further to my emails and letters to you please could you contact me urgently about the above vessel.

This vessel is currently unregistered and unlicensed. The fine for fishing with an unlicensed vessel is up to £50000.

You can either re-register your vessel and the licence can be re-instated or you can choose to remove the licence from the vessel and create an entitlement. This can then be transferred to another owner if you wish. Entitlements are valid for 5 years from the date of creation. In your case it would be from 1 July 2010 as you didn't renew your licence at this date.

It is of the utmost importance we resolve this matter and I look forward to you contacting me.

Further to my emails and phone conversations please could you advise on the situation regarding the above vessel.

The last time we spoke you said you were going to re-register the vessel in order to keep the licence on it. To date I have not received your new Certificate of Registry.

Please could you send a copy of it to this office in order for us to continue the re-licensing process.

If you have not re-registered the vessel you must now complete the AFL7 form I sent to you last year. This removes the licence from the vessel and places it into entitlement. This is valid for 5 years (back dated to 1 July 2010).

It is now becoming a matter of urgency that this matter is resolved.

May I remind you that it is an offence to fish without the authority of a licence.

Please do not hesitate to get in touch with me for further clarification and advice.

I have spoken with the RSS about your vessel and they have advised me that as you did not respond to the two reminder letters (one of which would be the February letter) they sent you, the registry for the [REDACTED] was closed in April.

This means that until the boat is re-registered it cannot have a fishing licence placed on it. Due to this I am sending you an AFL7 form to place the licence in to 'hip pocket'. Please sign and date the form at Section B. As you didn't renew your licence in 2010 the start date will be 1 July 2010, and you have 5 years from this date to place it.

I also enclose the forms you will require to re-register your vessel. If you contact RSS on 02920 448855 they will confirm the fee to be paid. It will help if you can quote you Official number (C18240).
