I have provided below a little bit of further explanation around the proposed objectives but please let me know if you need further details.

Some of the objectives relate to both pre and post waves and changes we are aiming for from one to the next and one relates to the post wave only. The changes and the rationale for each are summarised below

* Increase the proportion of people in Scotland who have heard of Hate Crime and definitely / think they know what it means by 3 percentage points from 87% to 90% by December 2017

87% at the pre-wave is a high baseline and therefore realistically we wouldn't expect this to increase by a huge amount. However, with the base sizes we have, 3 percentage points would be a significant increase.

* Shift the proportion of people in Scotland who think they know what Hate Crime means to be more definititive by 10 percentage points from 46% (saying have heard of it and definitely know what it means) to 56% by December 2017

This is like a sub-objective of the above and it seems reasonable to think this could be moved by a larger amount – hence the 10 percentage point figure.

* Increase the number of people in Scotland who claim they would report Hate Crime if they witnessed it by 5 percentage points by December 2017: from 64% who would report it to 69%

Again, a level of 64% seems like a fairly high baseline and we need to be realistic about what can be achieved especially given the campaign media and spend. A 5 percentage point improvement would, however, be significant.

* Achieve a 40% campaign motivation score in the Hate Crime evalution by December 2017

This is based on post wave data only and hasn't changed since the original.

Long term:

* Increase the number of people in Scotland who report Hate Crime via 101 or 999 by 7% yoy by December 2018

This is based on non-survey data and hasn't changed since the original.

I just wanted to flag up that the Hate Crime evaluation isn't a hugely positive read – see attached. TNS are making some changes following our feedback this morning but you can get the gist of it from the attachment. FYI - We've asked for comparisons against all adults in Scotland v C2DE for some of the areas.

The pre wave results were quite high so impacting on the post wave results not fully achieving objectives. There's some positive results from the campaigner recognisers but overall the impact of the campaign isn't as high as we'd like. Not sure if this is because the media spend was so low (£35k plus PR and platforms), whether we could have targeted further (perhaps a younger demographic) and applied a different media and creative strategy, or whether people struggle to engage with the campaign thinking it won't affect them? There was also a bit in there about people still being sacred to report a hate crime.
