Data Quality

> 2017/18

- 262 (2%) difference between HL3 and HL2
- largely known reasons for the differences
- 2% of HL3 cases were not matched to HL1

Q1 & Q2 2018/19

- 936 (9%) difference between HL3 and HL2
- some known reasons for the differences
- 1% of HL3 cases were not matched to HL1
