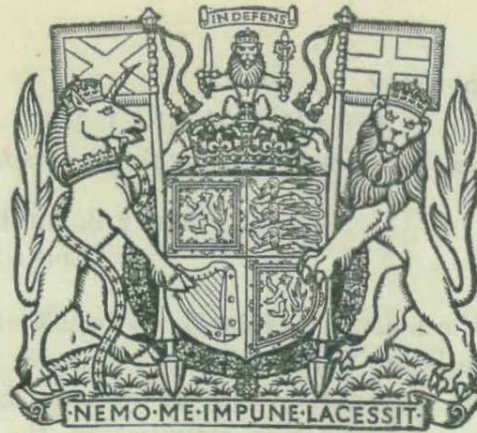

SIR,

I have the honour to submit, on behalf of the Fishery Board for Scotland, the Statistical Tables relating to the sea fisheries of Scotland for the year 1935. A narrative report on the fisheries and on the chief administrative and scientific activities of the Board during the year will shortly follow.

The Scottish fishing fleet in 1935 comprised 2,222 sailing vessels, 2,391 motor vessels, 644 steam drifters, 2 steam mussel dredgers, 25 steam liners as distinct from drifters, and 373 steam trawlers, or a total of 5,657 vessels, valued with their gear at £3,027,027, as against 5,764 vessels and £3,050,472 in 1934. In addition 268 English steam drifters fished in Scottish waters during the summer herring fishing. The number of Scottish fishermen was 22,175 (of whom 5,369 were crofter fishermen and 880 men were partially employed in fishing) as against 22,601 (including 5,416 crofter fishermen and 939 partially employed) in the preceding year. Shore workers and persons engaged in transport brought the total number employed in the Scottish fisheries to 59,992, as against 56,929 in 1934.

The total quantity of fish landed in Scotland by British fishing vessels during the year was 5,506,477 cwts., valued at £3,852,112, besides shell-fish valued at £91,625, as against 5,053,497 cwts., £3,544,211 and £92,404 respectively in 1934. In addition 218,084 cwts., valued at £124,581, were landed by foreign fishing vessels, mostly German trawlers engaged in the Icelandic fishing, as against 242,109 cwts. and £131,535 in the preceding year, making a grand total of 5,724,561 cwts., valued with shell-fish at £4,068,324, as compared with 5,295,606 cwts. and £3,768,151 in 1934. Herrings figured most prominently in the aggregate landings, contributing 3,026,233 cwts., valued at £1,092,138, against 2,490,525 cwts. and £833,480.

The total quantity of herrings cured, kippered, &c. amounted to 796,475 barrels (of which 631,949 were pickled gutted), valued after cure at £1,628,613, against a total of 626,411 barrels valued at £1,272,210 in 1934. Of other kinds of fish the quantity cured, chiefly by smoking or drying, amounted after cure to 389,612 cwts., valued at £960,230, as against 380,517 cwts. and £962,344 in 1934.

The exports of fish from Scotland included 620,508 barrels of herrings gutted and pickled, 8 ungutted, and 83,039 crans sprinkled with salt or iced, as against 493,617 barrels, 566 ungutted, and 89,798½ crans respectively in 1934, and 93,091 cwts. of dried, smoked, or pickled fish of various kinds, and 14,378 cwts. of fish preserved in other ways, as against 110,280 cwts. and 12,697 cwts. respectively in 1934.
