SIR,

I have the honour to submit, on behalf of the Fishery Board for Scotland, the Statistical Tables relating to the sea fisheries of Scotland for the year 1937. A narrative report on the fisheries and on the chief administrative and scientific activities of the Board during the year will shortly follow.

The Scottish fishing fleet in 1937 comprised 1,941 sailing vessels, 2,445 motor vessels, 459 steam drifters, 26 steam liners as distinct from drifters, and 346 steam trawlers, or a total of 5,217 vessels, valued with their gear at £2,776,662, as against 5,512 vessels and £2,959,696 in 1936. In addition 228 English steam drifters fished in Scottish waters during the summer herring fishing. The number of Scottish fishermen was 19,364 (of whom 4,355 were crofter fishermen and 896 men were partially employed in fishing) as against 21,480 (including 5,216 crofter fishermen and 992 partially employed) in the preceding year. Shore workers and persons engaged in transport brought the total number employed in the Scottish fisheries to 54,327, as against 58,506 in 1936.

The total quantity of fish landed in Scotland by British fishing vessels during the year was 4,701,657 cwts., valued at £3,422,178, besides shell-fish valued at £92,734, as against 5,064,782 cwts., £3,788,007 and £89,923 respectively in 1936. In addition 152,136 cwts., valued at £113,907, were landed by foreign fishing vessels, mostly German and Icelandic trawlers and Swedish seiners, as against 143,654 cwts. and £111,509 in the preceding year, making a grand total of 4,853,793 cwts., valued with shell-fish at £3,628,837, as compared with 5,208,436 cwts. and £3,989,446 in 1936. Herrings figured most prominently in the aggregate landings, contributing 2,140,093 cwts., valued at £962,318, against 2,700,346 cwts. and £1,193,361 in the previous year.

The total quantity of herrings cured, kippered, &c. amounted to 536,184 barrels (of which 377,794 were pickled gutted), valued after cure at £1,366,465, against a total of 673,536 barrels valued at £1,590,621 in 1936. Of other kinds of fish the quantity cured, chiefly by smoking or drying, amounted after cure to 397,961 cwts., valued at £990,221, as against 363,712 cwts. and £863,896 in 1936.

The exports of fish from Scotland included 372,432½ barrels of herrings gutted and pickled and 47,204 crans sprinkled with salt or iced, as against 516,447½ barrels and 125,215 crans respectively in 1936, and 79,121 cwts. of dried, smoked, or pickled fish of various kinds, and 10,045 cwts. of fish preserved in other ways, as against 100,409 cwts. and 5,297 cwts. respectively in 1936.
