Foreword

Fish landed.—The total quantity of wet fish landed in Scotland by British vessels during the year was 5,978,306 cwt. valued at £11,238,503, compared with 6,412,838 cwt. and £10,678,068 in 1953. The value of shell fish landed was £374,882 as against £298,276 in 1953. In addition 117,891 cwt. of wet fish valued at £239,964 and shell fish valued at £133 were landed by Swedish, German, Belgian, Faroese and Danish fishing vessels as against 147,309 cwt. and £306,103 in the previous year, making a grand total of 6,096,197 cwt. valued with shell fish at £11,853,482, compared with 6,560,147 cwt. and £11,282,503 in 1953. Herring landed by British vessels contributed 2,607,593 cwt. valued at £2,300,270 as against 3,021,559 cwt. and £2,621,580 in 1953, and demersal fish landed by British vessels amounted to 3,259,416 cwt. valued at £8,865,407, compared with 3,185,656 cwt. and £7,953,186 in 1953. Foreign fishing vessels landed 57,770 cwt. of herring compared with 43,473 cwt. in 1953 and 57,205 cwt. of demersal fish compared with 102,932 cwt. in the previous year.

Fish cured.—The total quantity of herring cured, kippered, etc., amounted to 307,517 barrels (of which 131,295 were kippered and 136,477 pickle-cured) valued after cure at £2,833,726, compared with a total of 306,834 barrels valued at £2,748,497 in 1953. Of other kinds of fish the quantity cured, chiefly by smoking or canning, amounted after cure to 252,950 cwt. valued at £1,864,134 as against 237,752 cwt. and £1,700,836 in 1953.

Fishing fleet.—The Scottish fishing fleet in 1954 comprised 208 steam trawlers, 3 motor trawlers, 17 steam liners, 6 steam drifters, 3,164 motor vessels and 269 sail vessels, a total of 3,667 vessels compared with 4,493 vessels in 1953 (see Explanatory Notes).

Fishermen.—The number of Scottish fishermen was 12,551 (of whom 1,990 were crofter fishermen and 1,093 were partially employed in fishing) as against 13,450 (including 2,115 crofter fishermen and 1,436 partially employed) in the previous year.

Explanatory Notes

Form of tables

The tables in this publication differ from those in reports published since the year 1949 but are similar in form to those used in the report for the year 1938. More detailed information is provided by the inclusion of (a) three tables (Tables 3, 4 and 5) which give the quantity, value and average price of each kind of fish landed in each year since 1947 and in 1913 and 1938, (b) a table (Table 2) giving the quantity and value of fish landed by each method of fishing in each year since 1947 and in 1938 and (c) a table (Table 12) giving particulars of each kind of fish caught by British drifters and ringers in each district.

Fishery districts

There were changes in the composition and nomenclature of certain fishery districts as from 1st January, 1954, and the revised list is as follows:—

Fishing fleet

The Foreword indicates that there was a reduction in the Scottish fishing fleet of 826 vessels in 1954 compared with 1953. That figure includes reductions in the numbers of motor and sail vessels of 361 and 418 respectively which are largely due to a change in the basis upon which the statistics have been compiled, registered fishing vessels which are not engaged in fishing being now excluded. The actual net decline in the number of motor vessels engaged in fishing was 109.
