## FOREWORD

**Fish Landed.** The total quantity of wet fish landed in Scotland by British vessels during the year was 5,861,140 cwt. valued at £14,704,255 compared with 5,086,338 cwt. valued at £13,766,959 in 1962. The quantity of shell fish landed was 200,174 cwt. valued at £1,364,305 compared with 183,042 cwt. valued at £1,319,006 in 1962. In addition 176,921 cwt. of wet fish valued at £553,824 and 4 cwt. of shell fish, valued at £23 were landed by Danish, Dutch, Faroese, German, Icelandic, Polish, Norwegian and Swedish fishing vessels as against 175,274 cwt. of wet fish and 57 cwt. of shell fish valued at £571,898 and £220 respectively in 1962, making a grand total of 6,038,061 cwt. of wet fish valued at £15,258,079 (1962, 5,261,612 cwt. valued at £14,338,857) and 200,178 cwt. of shell fish valued at £1,364,328 (1962, 183,099 cwt. valued at £1,319,226). Herring landed by British vessels amounted to 1,567,114 cwt. valued at £1,931,216 as against 1,486,646 cwt. and £2,090,956 in 1962, and demersal fish landed by British vessels amounted to 3,648,424 cwt. valued at £12,583,523 compared with 3,405,611 cwt. valued at £11,530,986 in the previous year. Foreign fishing vessels landed 46,822 cwt. of herring compared with 20,363 cwt. in 1962, and 121,420 cwt. of demersal fish compared with 149,611 cwt. in 1962.

**Fish Processed.** The quantity of herring kippered, redded or canned was 213,191 crans valued, after process, at £3,029,291 compared with 198,712 crans valued at £2,931,807 in 1962. In addition 29,943 barrels of herring valued at £178,996 were pickle-cured as against 20,632 barrels and £121,613 in 1962. Of other kinds of fish, the quantity processed, chiefly by smoking or canning, amounted after process to 226,463 cwt. valued at £2,144,220 as against 271,373 cwt. and £2,647,110 in 1962.

**Fishing Fleet.** The Scottish fishing fleet at 31st December, 1963, comprised 12 steam trawlers, 148 motor trawlers, 2,777 other motor vessels and 44 sail vessels, a total of 2,981 vessels compared with 3,063 vessels in 1962.

**Fishermen.** The total number of Scottish fishermen at 31st December, 1963, was 10,527 of whom 2,238 (including 991 crofter fishermen) were only partially employed in fishing. The number of fishermen at 31st December, 1962, was 10,610 of whom 2,169 (including 1,057 crofter fishermen) were only partially employed in fishing.

**United Kingdom Statistics.** For convenient reference United Kingdom statistics are shown in Table I. Statistics in all other Tables relate solely to Scotland.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

### Crabs, Lobsters and Oysters

From 1st January, 1958, the landings of crabs, lobsters and oysters have been recorded in cwts. instead of numbers as previously.

### Shrimps and Cockles

From 1st January, 1962, the landings of shrimps and cockles have been recorded separately, instead of being included with "other shell fish" as previously.

### Classification of Squids

In the tables for 1954 and earlier years, squids were classified as demersal fish. It was decided in view of the zoological classification of squids as members of the mollusc group that it was more appropriate for statistical purposes to classify them as shell fish. Effect has been given to that decision in the tables from 1955.
