## FOREWORD

**Fish Landed.** The total quantity of wet fish landed in Scotland by British vessels during the year was 6,594,164 cwt. valued at £18,918,521 compared with 6,550,491 cwt. valued at £18,558,831 in 1967. The quantity of shell fish landed was 281,072 cwt. valued at £2,787,284 compared with 230,998 cwt. valued at £2,122,915 in 1967. In addition 600,410 cwt. of wet fish valued at £573,125 was landed by Danish, Faroese, Icelandic, Norwegian, Swedish and West German fishing vessels as against 183,500 cwt. of wet fish and 340 cwt. of shell fish valued at £319,990 and £1,781 respectively in 1967, making a grand total of 7,194,574 cwt. of wet fish valued at £19,491,646 (1967, 6,733,991 cwt. valued at £18,878,821) and 281,072 cwt. of shell fish valued at £2,787,284 (1967, 231,338 cwt. valued at £2,124,696). Herring landed by British vessels amounted to 1,648,845 cwt. valued at £2,145,180 as against 1,734,960 cwt. and £2,188,959 in 1967 and demersal fish landed by British vessels amounted to 4,326,825 cwt. valued at £16,503,512 compared with 4,268,723 cwt. valued at £16,140,256 in the previous year. Foreign fishing vessels landed 316,696 cwt. of herring compared with 112,267 cwt. in 1967 and 280,582 cwt. of demersal fish compared with 60,207 cwt. in 1967.

**Fish Processed.** The quantity of herring kippered, redded, canned or marinated, was 212,464 crans, valued after process at £3,604,478 compared with 192,121 crans valued at £3,060,906 in 1967. In addition 12,770 barrels of herring valued at £165,655 were pickle-cured as against 22,494 barrels and £239,646 in 1967. Of other kinds of fish, the quantity processed, chiefly by smoking or canning, amounted after process to 277,282 cwt. valued at £3,383,833 as against 204,773 cwt. and £2,417,860 in 1967.

**Fishing Fleet.** The Scottish fishing fleet at 31st December 1968 comprised 123 motor trawlers over 80 ft., and 2,664 other motor vessels, a total of 2,787 vessels compared with 2,877 vessels in 1967.

**Fishermen.** The total number of Scottish fishermen at 31st December 1968 was 9,667 of whom 1,740 (including 401 crofter fishermen) were only partially employed in fishing. The number of fishermen at 31st December 1967 was 9,904 of whom 1,847 (including 552 crofter fishermen) were only partially employed in fishing.

**United Kingdom Statistics.** For convenient reference United Kingdom statistics are shown in Table I. Statistics in all other Tables relate solely to Scotland.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

### Fishing Vessels

Unless otherwise stated, fishing vessels are shown in registered lengths.

### Shrimps and Cockles

From 1st January 1962 the landings of shrimps and cockles have been recorded separately, instead of being included with "other shell fish" as previously.

### Periwinkles

From 1st January 1966 the landings of Periwinkles have been recorded separately, instead of being included with "other shell fish as" previously.

### Classification of Squids

In the tables for 1954 and earlier years, squids were classified as demersal fish. It was decided in view of the zoological classification of squids as members of the mollusc group that it was more appropriate for statistical purposes to classify them as shell fish. Effect has been given to that decision in the tables from 1955.
