## FOREWORD

**Fish Landed.** The total quantity of wet fish landed in Scotland by British vessels during the year was 8,477,065 cwt. valued at £30,598,930 compared with 7,810,776 cwt. valued at £23,287,792 in 1970. The quantity of shell fish landed was 444,404 cwt. valued at £4,406,011 compared with 444,810 cwt. valued at £3,952,821 in 1970. In addition 437,194 cwt. of wet fish valued at £422,235 and 36 cwt. of shellfish valued at £314 was landed by Danish, Faroese, Icelandic, Irish Republic, Norwegian and Swedish fishing vessels as against 580,184 cwt. of wet fish valued at £703,019 in 1970, making a grand total of 8,914,259 cwt. of wet fish valued at £31,021,165 (1970, 8,390,960 cwt. valued at £23,990,811) and 444,440 cwt. of shell fish valued at £4,406,325 (1970, 444,874 cwt. valued at £3,953,133). Herring landed by British vessels amounted to 2,615,240 cwt. valued at £4,429,647 as against 2,493,884 cwt. and £4,010,967 in 1970, and demersal fish landed by British vessels amounted to 5,372,474 cwt. valued at £25,704,491 compared with 4,933,278 cwt. valued at £18,957,528 in the previous year. Foreign fishing vessels landed 143,126 cwt. of herring compared with 302,902 cwt. in 1970 and 275,404 cwt. of demersal fish compared with 261,520 cwt. in 1970.

**Fish Processed.** The quantity of herring kippered, pickle-cured, canned or marinated was after process 719,794 cwt. valued at £7,376,247 compared with 590,852 cwt. valued at £6,461,550. Of other kinds of fish, the quantity processed, chiefly by smoking or canning, amounted after process to 288,056 cwt. valued at £3,658,908 as against 519,606 cwt. and £7,023,497 in 1970.

**Fishing Fleet.** The Scottish fishing fleet at 31st December 1971 comprised 117 trawlers over 80 ft., and 2,503 other motor vessels, a total of 2,620 vessels compared with 2,617 vessels in 1970.

**Fishermen.** The total number of Scottish fishermen at 31st December 1971 was 9,332 of whom 1,435 (including 264 crofter fishermen) were only partially employed in fishing. The number of fishermen at 31st December 1970 was 9,097 of whom 1,441 (including 269 crofter fishermen) were only partially employed in fishing.

**United Kingdom Statistics.** For convenient reference United Kingdom statistics are shown in Table 1. Statistics in all other Tables relate solely to Scotland.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

### Landings

The quantities are expressed in terms of the landed weight. In the case of demersal fish (excluding Norway Pout) this is for head on, gutted fish; for other species including shellfish it is for whole ungutted fish.

### Fishing Vessels

Unless otherwise stated, fishing vessels are shown in registered lengths.

### Dover Sole and Norway Pout

From 1st January 1970 the landings of Dover Sole and Norway Pout have been recorded separately. Previously the landings of Dover Sole were included with "Lemon sole" and the landings of Norway Pout with "Other demersal fish".

### Periwinkles

From 1st January 1966 the landings of Periwinkles have been recorded separately, instead of being included with "other shell fish" as previously.

### Other Shell Fish

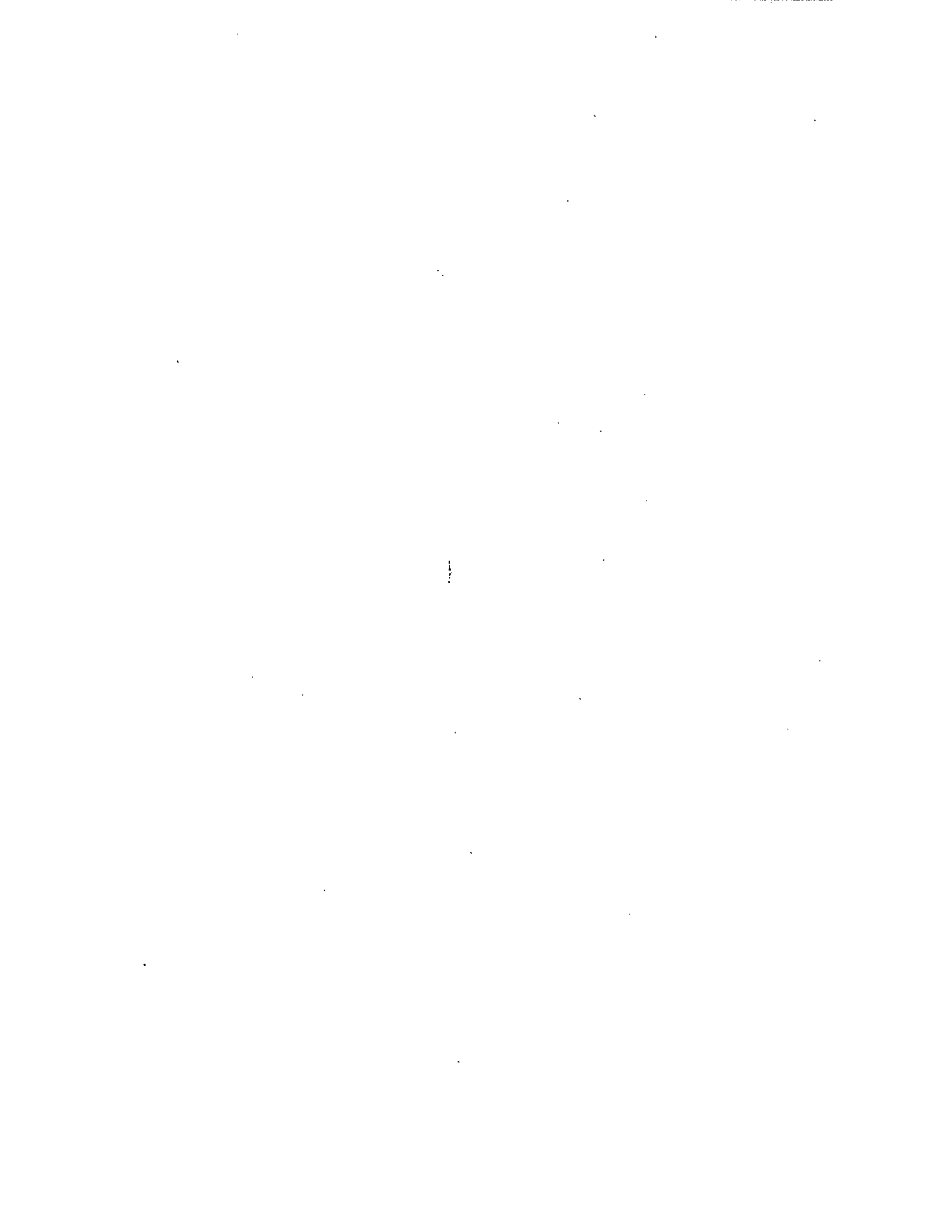
From 1st February 1970 the landings of Queens have been included with "Other shell fish" instead of with scallops as previously. "Other shell fish" now consists primarily of Queens.
