Chart 1: Number of Assets in Community Ownership, 2000 to 2020

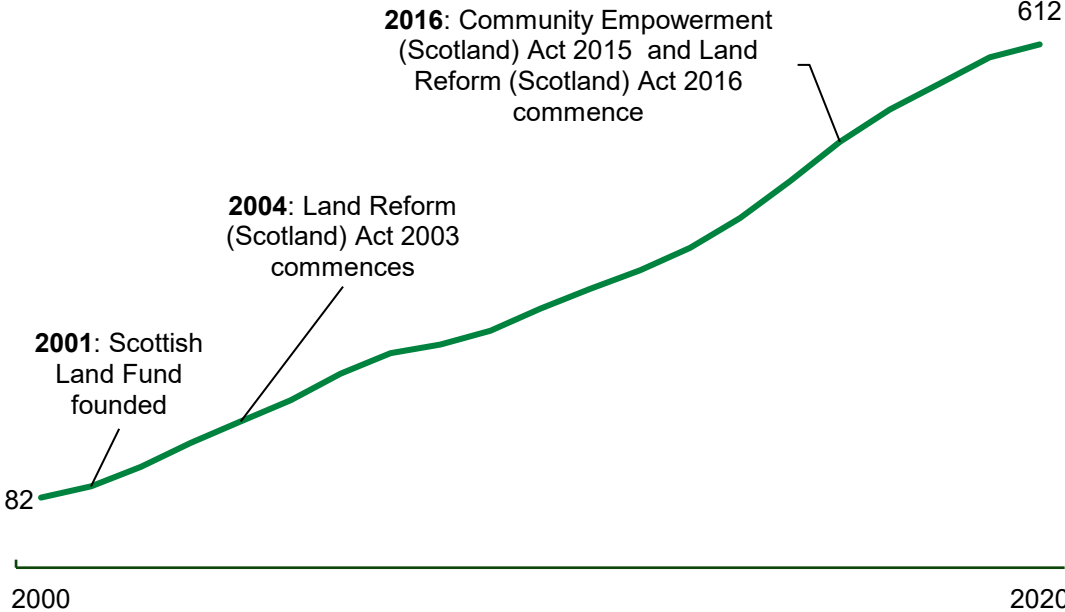

Chart 2: Number of Community Groups Owning Assets, 2000 to 2020

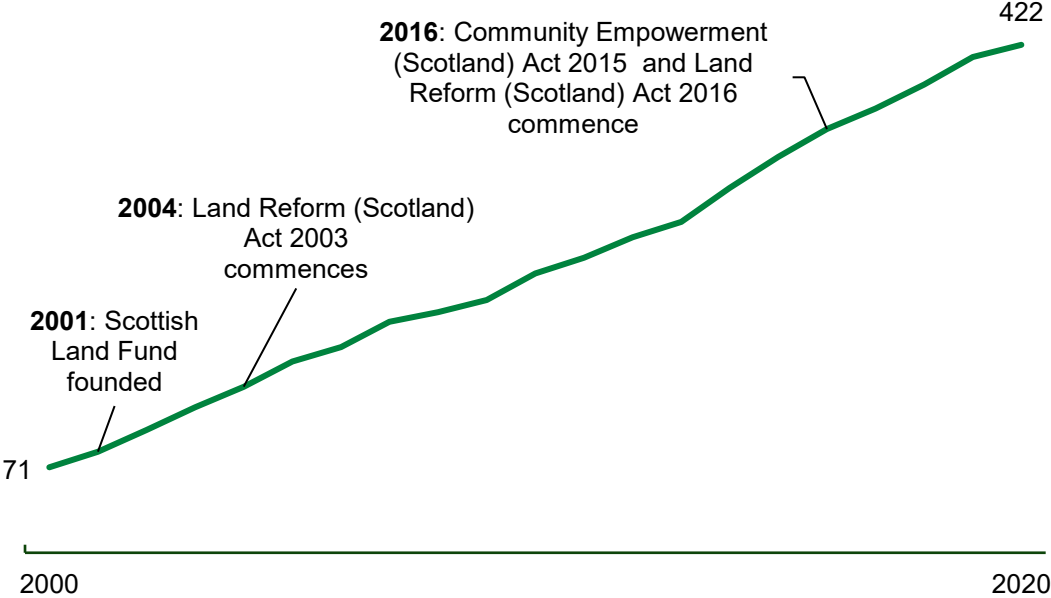

Chart 3: Area of Assets in Community Ownership for Highland, Na h-Eileanan Siar and Scotland, 2000 to 2020

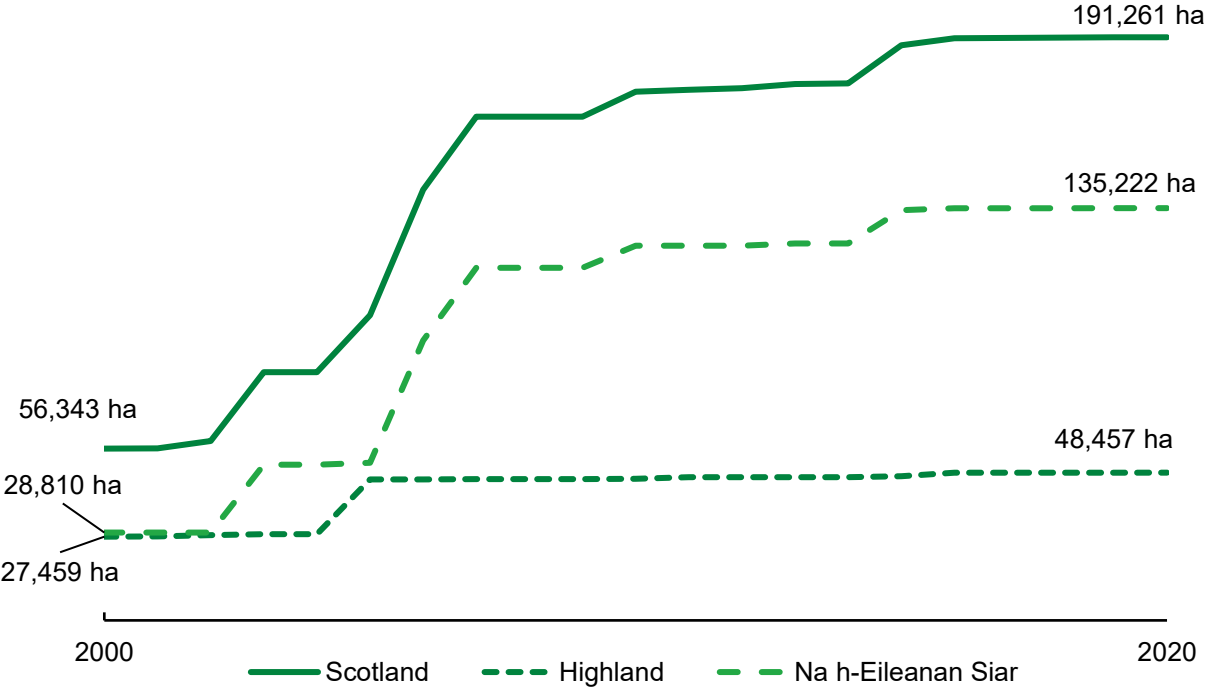

Chart 4: Number of Assets in Community Ownership and Length of Ownership as at December 2020

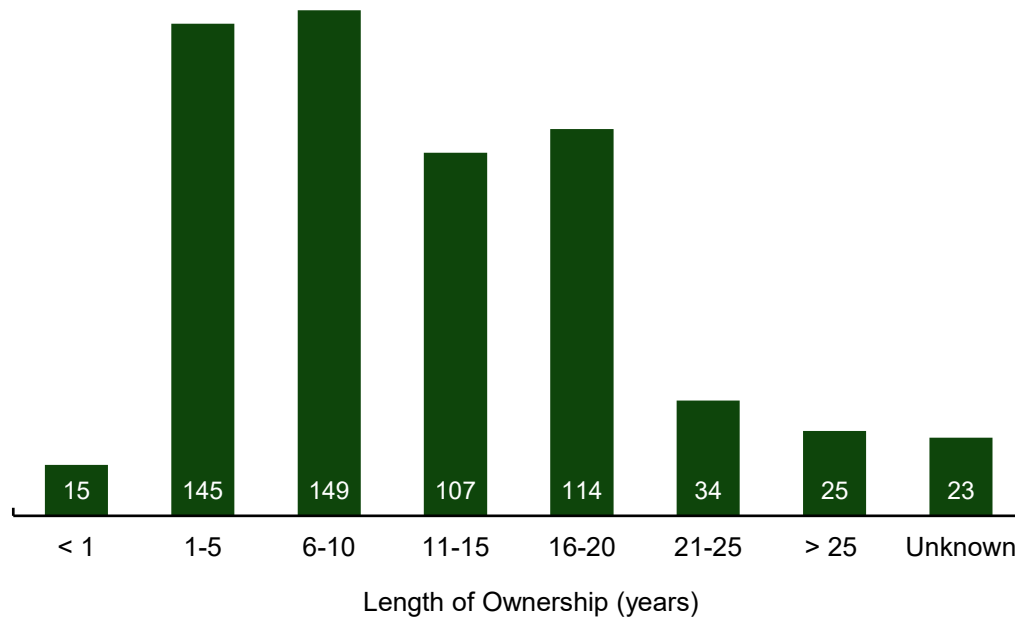

Chart 5: Number of Assets in Community Ownership and Purchase Price as at December 2020

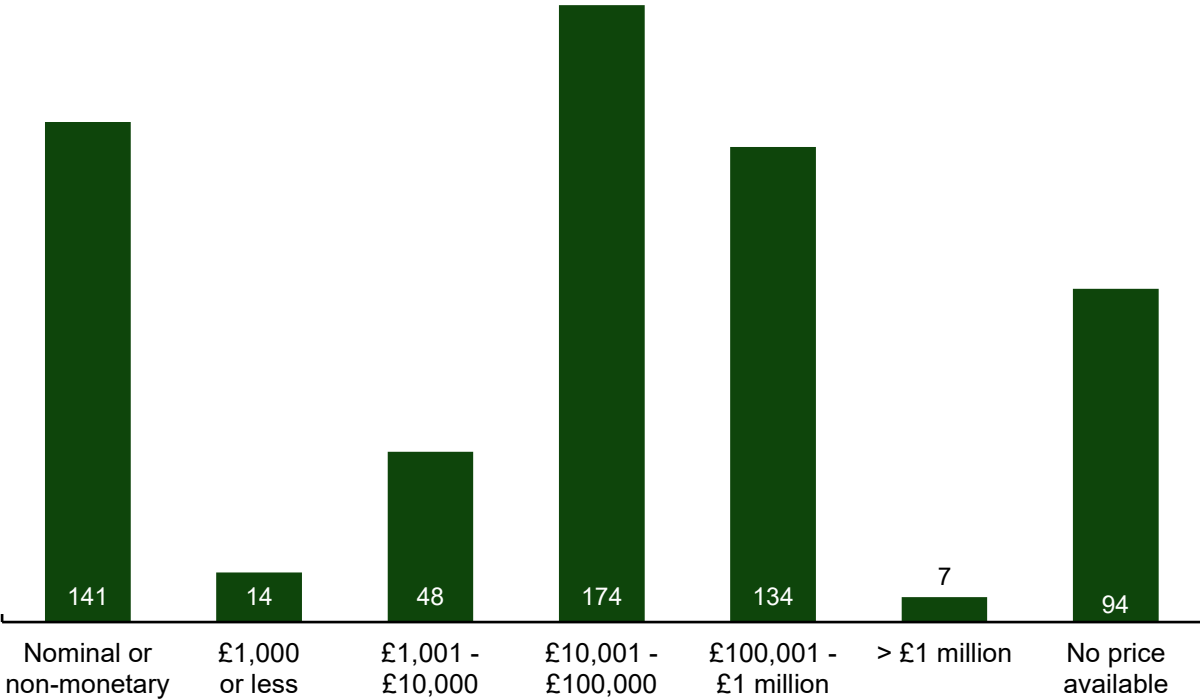

Chart 6: Number of Assets and Area in Community Ownership by Asset Size as at December 2020

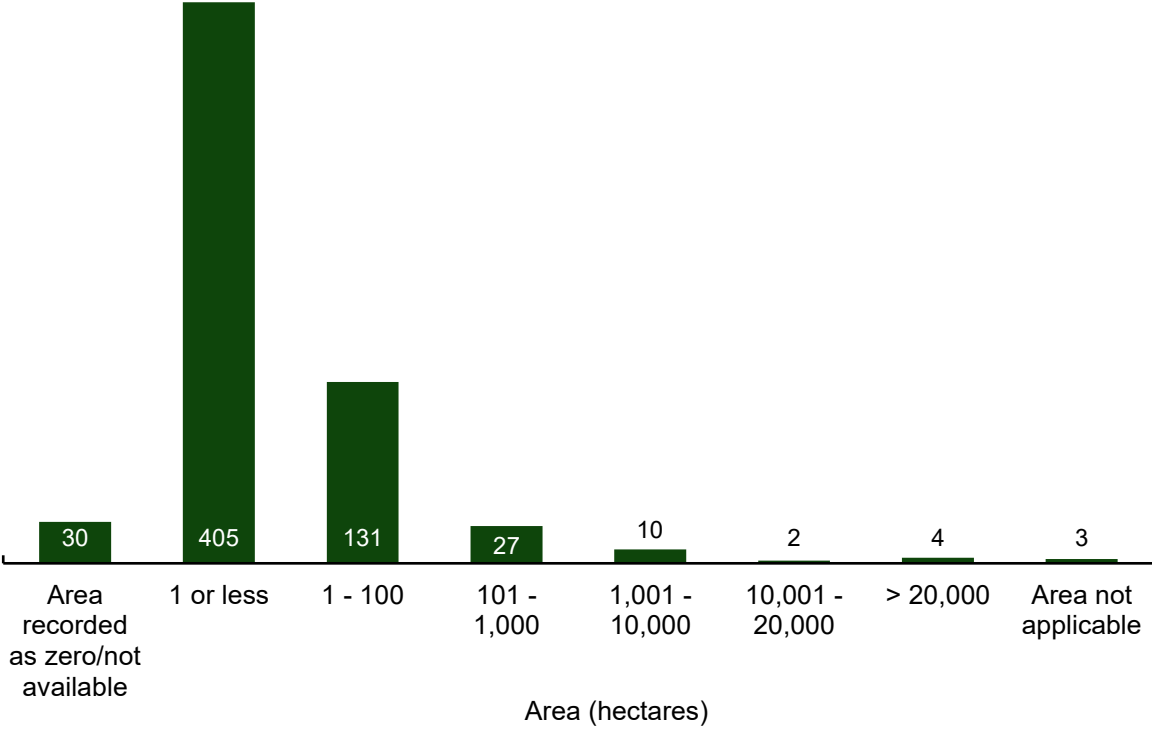

Chart 7: Number of Assets in Community Ownership by Asset Type as at December 2020

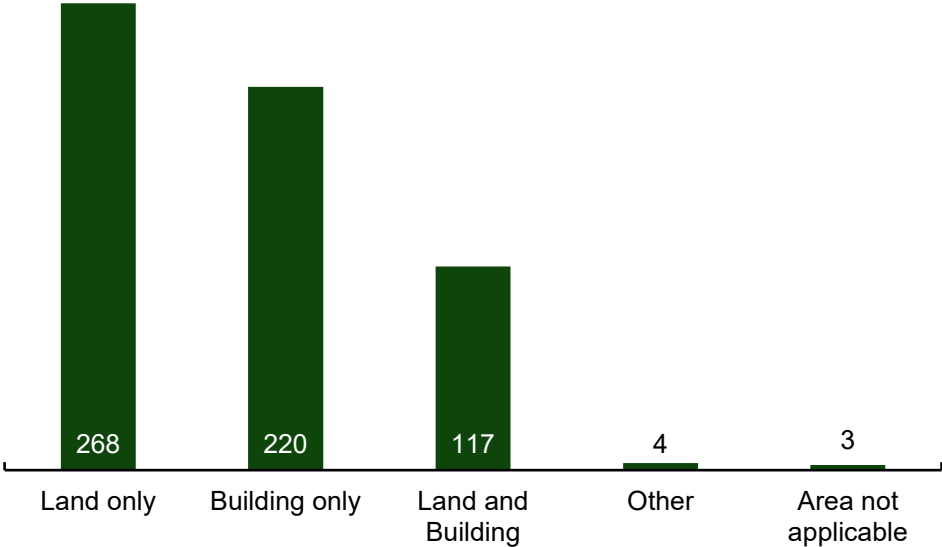

Chart 8: Number of Assets in Community Ownership by the Scottish Government Urban Rural Classification 2016 as at December 2020

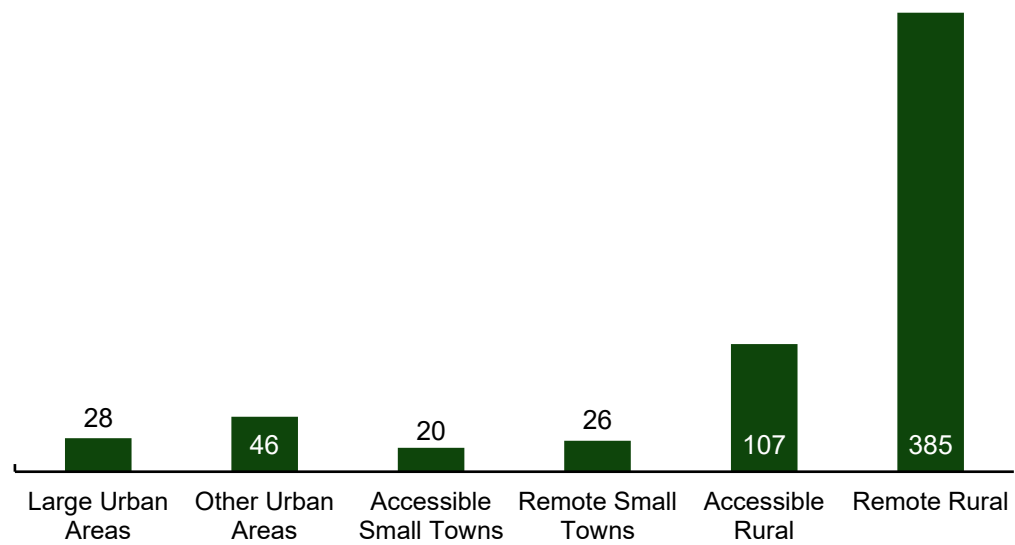

Chart 9: Area of Assets in Community Ownership for Na h-Eileanan Siar, Highland and the Rest of Scotland as at December 2020

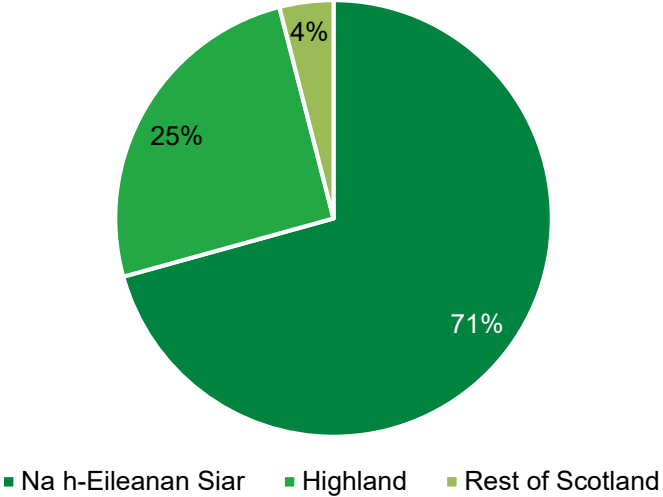
