

# Covid-19 Education Recovery Group - Infographic

As at 27th September 2020:

- There have been 989 children and young people aged 2-17 years in Scotland who have tested positive for COVID-19 since the start of the outbreak.

In the week ending 27<sup>th</sup> September 2020:

- There were 259 children and young people aged 2-17 years in Scotland who tested positive for COVID-19, among the 4,317 children and young people who were tested.

On 29<sup>th</sup> September:

- Attendance in local authority schools was 92.9%, whilst the percentages of openings recorded as pupils not in school (non Covid-19 reasons) was 5.4%, and for not in school (Covid-19 related reasons) was 1.7%.

- 11,641 pupils were not in school either all or part of the day because of Covid-19 related reasons.

- 1,571 staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons, of which, 978 were teaching staff and 593 were other school-based staff.

- 73,446 children were attending a childcare setting and 1,050 had a Covid-19 related absence.

- 430 (2.4%) childcare staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons [based on a 48% response rate].
