

# Covid-19 Education Recovery Group - Infographic

## In the week ending 27<sup>th</sup> June 2021:

- The rate of testing was 1,871.8 per 100,000 children and young people aged 2-17 years.
- The percentage of tests that were positive was 11.8% in those aged 2-17 years; an increase from 8.2% last week.
- The identified COVID-19 positive cases reflected a rate of 127.8 cases per 100,000 2-4 year olds, 357.0 cases per 100,000 5-11 year olds, 445.3 per 100,000 12-15 year olds and 692.2 cases per 100,000 16-17 year olds. The rate of cases per 100,000 of the general population was 355.1.
- 25,246 children were attending a childcare setting and 1,533 had a Covid-19 related absence. Note that not all open settings completed the survey and that these figures are an underestimate of the actual number of open settings and children attending.
- This week, 717 (5.7%) childcare staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons [based on a 25% response rate].
