Additional Case Information:

Site inspection undertaken to observe procedures for transfer of stock off site, following reports of feral farmed fish being caught in Loch Ness.

CNA and Escape investigation conducted 16/11/22 - refer to case 20220474

Inspection conducted 14/12/22 to observed procedures for movement of stock from site to jetty at shorebase, due to weather conditions it was not possible to inspect the movement of stock off - refer to case 20220595

Two pens were secured to the jetty prior to arrival of inspector on site. Both pens were emptied during the inspection. No issues were observed with the transfer process, with all pipework securely in place, all equipment appeared in good operational order and site procedures were followed. Netting was placed over the walkway when intake pipe was moved between cages and during netting of final fish to flexi tubs.

An inspection was conducted to observe the transfer of stock from pens, that had been transferred from site to the jetty at the shorebase, for onwards journey to a wellboat. This inspection was a follow up to the enhanced containment inspection conducted on 16/11/22, case number 20220474 and the inspection of procedures for transferring pens from the site to the jetty conducted on 14/12/22, case number 20220595.

No issues were noted during the inspection of stock transfer from pens to tanks for onwards transport. Therefore, no recommendations are to be made in relation to that procedure.
