Site holds a small number of TRO, which come directly from ova collected at the top loch on site

RTR are supplied by Hoghill fish farm, who are their sole supplier. Previously RTR were supplied by Ae fishery. The last input of rainbow trout was this morning.

There is a lot of natural stock held on site which is found in the top loch.

The hatchery belongs to the local salmon fishery board, but it is used by the club. The club used to use the hatchery to stock fish to the Glaisnock river, under licence from MSS, however this has not occurred in ~the last five years. Now, the hatchery is used to rear TRO, which come from ova from fish in the top loch. There is no stocking of fish outside of the loch, or catchment.

There have been several issues lately within the club and a number of inspections from other agencies have been the result of complaints.
